



Cookie policy

1. What are cookies?

Cookies are small text files that websites or applications send to the user's computer or other access device to remember information about you, such as your language preference or your login information.

For all the cookies on this site we provide you with the following information:

- Cookies subgroup: here you can find the web address of the person responsible for the cookie.
- Cookie: The name of the cookie.
- The cookies we use, depending on the entity that manages them, can be:
 - Our own: We create and manage them as responsible for the web.
 - From Third Parties: from third parties (which are cookies from a different domain than the domain the website you are visiting).
- Duration: Shows the time that the cookie remains stored on your computer or other access device, according to this it can be:
 - Session cookies: these are cookies designed to collect and store data while the user accesses a web page. They are usually used to store information that is only relevant for the provision of the service requested by the user on a single occasion.
- Persistent: Persistent Cookies are a type of cookie in which the data is still stored in the terminal and which can be accessed and processed during a period defined by the person responsible for the cookie, which can range from a few minutes to several years.

2. Disable the use of Cookies

If the user wants, it is possible to stop accepting browser Cookies, or stop accepting Cookies from a particular service.

All modern browsers allow you to change Cookie settings. These settings are usually found in the "Options" or "Preferences" of the browser menu.

The user may, at any time, disable the use of Cookies on this website by using the browser settings, for example:

3. What happens when you disable cookies?

Some functionalities and services may be disabled or have a different behaviour than expected, such as, for example, remaining identified, keeping purchases in the “shopping cart” in an electronic commerce service or receiving information directed to your location, among others. If you disable the use of Cookies on this website, it is likely that you will no longer be able to access certain areas of it or that the browsing experience on it will be significantly degraded.

4. Update of the Cookies Policy

As responsible for the site, European Vitreoretinal Society (EVRIS) e.V. can modify this Cookies Policy based on legislative or regulatory requirements, or with the purpose of adapting said policy to the instructions issued by the German Agency for Data Protection. Therefore users are advised to visit it periodically. When significant changes occur in this Cookies Policy, the entity will proceed to reflect them on the web. Below we offer you this information for each of the cookies on this website classified by purpose.

5. Cookies of this web page according to its functionality

Technical Cookies (strictly necessary)

These cookies are necessary for the website to function and cannot be disabled in our systems. They are usually configured to respond to your requests and interactions with this site, such as adjusting your privacy preferences, logging in, or completing forms. You can set your browser to block or alert the presence of these cookies, but some parts of the website will not work.

Analysis or measurement cookies

These cookies allow us to count visits, as well as navigation in order to measure and improve the performance of our site. They help us to know which pages are the most or least popular, and to see how many people visit the site. All information these cookies collect is generally aggregated and therefore anonymous. If you do not allow these cookies, we will not be able to know that you have visited our website or your browsing preferences.

Preference cookies

These cookies allow you to customise some features of the general options of the web page. For example, define the language, wallpaper, etc.
